

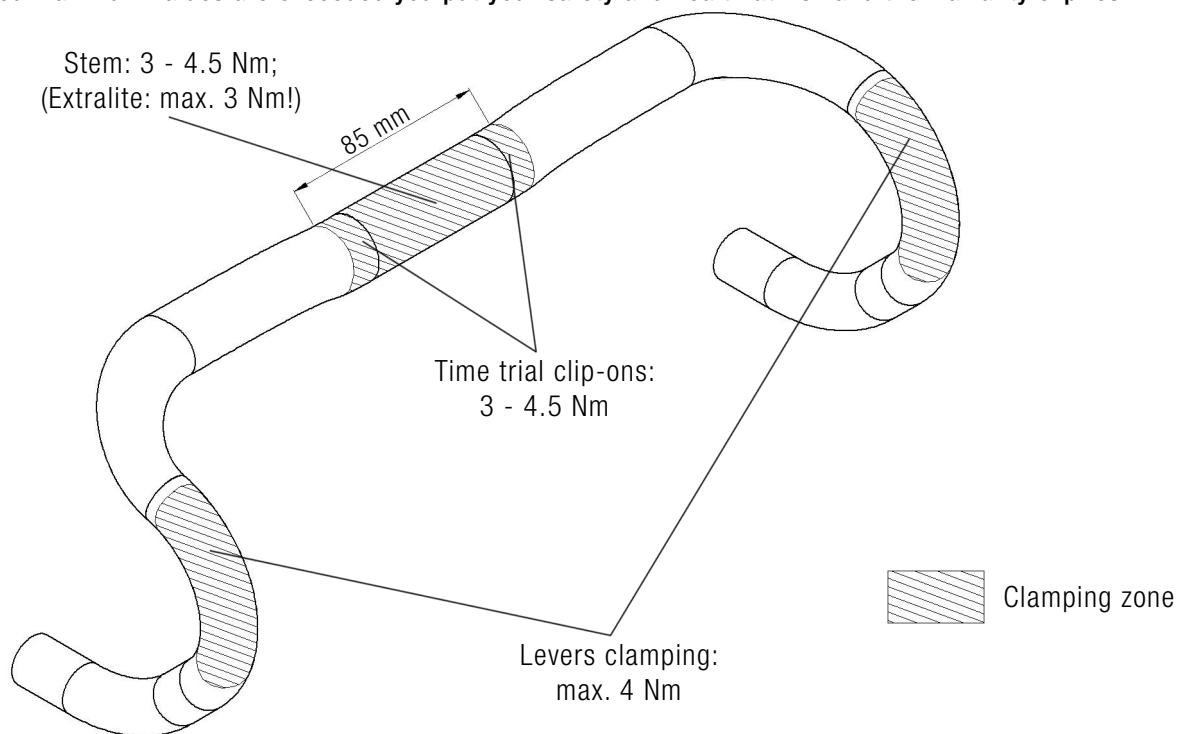
## INSTRUCTION SHEET FOR ROAD HANDLEBAR OVERSIZE

For an ergonomically ideal seat position clamp the handlebar with its lower straight parallel to the floor.

Your handlebar is made of extremely strong carbon fibres which are highly tear-resistant. Due to the nature of the material they are vulnerable to pressure or when being cut by sharp edges. Hence we must ask you to follow the safety instructions below to the letter:

- If there are any sharp edges at the clamping parts these must be smoothed using a file or emery paper.
- Take care that no dirt or metal chips are trapped inside the tightening zone.
- Do not drill the handlebar.
- The bars may not be shortened by more than 10 mm on each side, so please make sure to order the right size for your requirements.
- Pay attention to the permitted tightening torques!  
**Stem: 3 to 4 Nm; (Extralite: up to 3 Nm!)**  
**Levers clamping: up to 4 Nm**  
**Time trial clip-ons: 3 to 4.5 Nm**
- Apply the enclosed fitting paste on the tightening zone. This paste increases friction and reduces the necessary tightening torques by 1.5 Nm.
- Do not tighten the screws to the specified maximum values at first. Start at the lowest specified values and check if the connection is tight enough. If necessary increase the tightening torques, but do not exceed the specified maxima. Low clamping forces relieve the bar and raise its long-life cycle.

**If the specified maximum values are exceeded you put your safety and health at risk and the warranty expires.**
